

## **Marshal Coordinator's Report**

- 6 marshals on the fell this year
- 4 controls were manned alongside Raynet personnel:
- Control 103, sheepfold north side Sail Pass, third checkpoint on Classic & Medium courses
- Control 104, sheepfold in Little Dale, fourth checkpoint on Classic course
- Control 108, sheepfold in Addacombe Hole, fourth checkpoint on Medium course
- Control 112, stream junction in Clews Gill, third control on Short course
- Raynet supplied 6 personnel this year, 4 covering the manned controls and 2 at race control in Loweswater Village Hall.
- Marshals were supplied with First Aid Kit, KISU Shelter, Space Blanket, Emergency Food and Thermos Flask in order to administer to distressed competitors.
- Marshals recorded race numbers which were relayed back to race control. This assisted checking of overdue competitors. Marshals stayed in place after the control closure time to account for any competitors arriving after the closure time until stood down by race control.
- The system generally works well, but relies on the establishment of a radio path by Raynet and communication between marshals and the radio operator.
